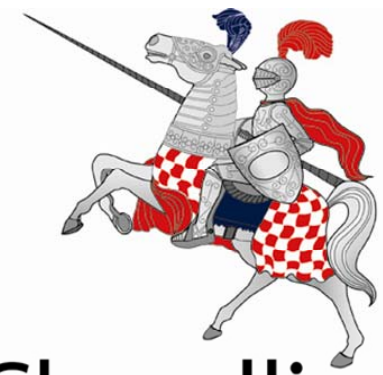

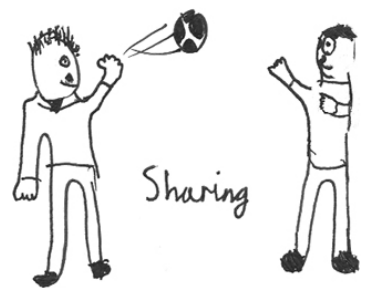
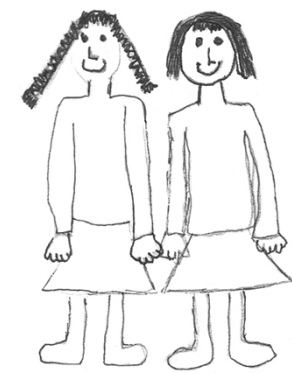


Chandlings

Don't think **you** are the only person in the world who matters

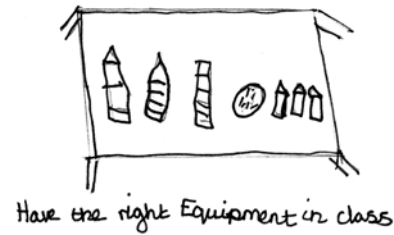
Have respect in the playground
